- **Logical Reasoning (two sections):** These sections consist of questions that require you to analyze arguments and draw s from the information provided.
- **Analytical Reasoning (one section):** This section consists of questions that require you to analyze logical relationships and draw s

from the information provided.

- **Reading Comprehension (one section):** This section consists of questions that require you to read and understand passages of text and answer questions about the content of the passages.
- **Experimental Section (one section):** This section is not scored and is used by the Law School Admission Council (LSAC) to test new questions.

The October 2024 LSAT is scored on a scale of 120 to 180. The average score is 150. A score of 160 or higher is considered to be a good score.

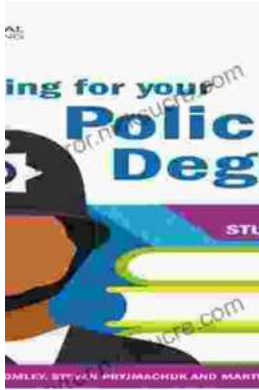
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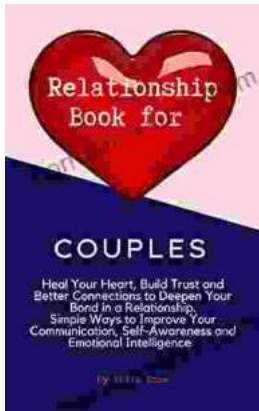
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
